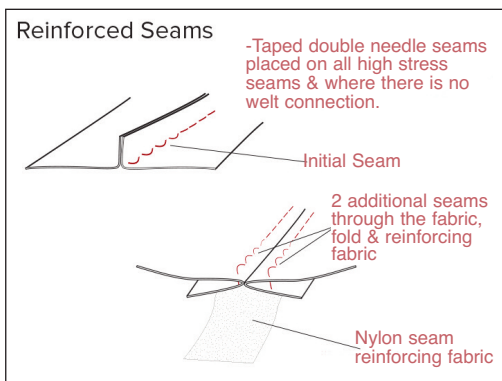
We are excited to be quoting you our heavy-use upholstered seating for your facility.

It can be hard to see the difference between contract-grade seating and retail seating at a glance but the differences are substantial.

Here are a few things to consider:



- Furniture Concepts' seating is designed and built for heavy-use environments. Frames are constructed with solid hardwoods with high-strength finger joinery and reinforced corner blocking. Retail furniture is typically built with composite materials that are stapled and glued which is not strong enough for the challenges of heavy-use.



- Furniture Concepts' upholstered seating is sewn with reinforced seams to prevent any gapping or tearing. Retail construction uses single needle construction that can give out causing tears over time.

- Furniture Concepts' upholstered seating uses high density upholstery foam to ensure minimal compression over time. Retail seating uses lower density foam that compresses over time causing dips in the seat and back cushions.

- Furniture Concepts' fabrics and vinyls have to pass a large number of tests to prove durability including an independent laboratory-run double rub test. We offer fabrics and vinyls with minimum standards 50,000 and up to 1,000,000 double rubs. Retail fabrics typically offer 5,000 – 10,000 double rubs.

- Furniture Concepts' fabrics comply with public use fire standards. Always check with local fire officials to verify which standards are required. Additionally, special health care fabric treatments that prevent fluid penetration and provide anti-microbial & anti-fungal properties are available.

- Furniture Concepts builds their upholstered seating in the USA and offers a 10 year heavy-use warranty against manufacturer's defects.
